

OAK HARBOR FOOTBALL & CHEER LEAGUE PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- Players will attend all practices, games, meetings and any other team functions on time.
- Players will show respect and good sportsmanship towards all coaches, players, cheerleaders, officials, volunteers and parents at all times.
- Players will not fight, use foul language or argue with coaches or teammates, on or off the field.
- Players will not incur an unsportsmanlike behavior penalty or display conduct detrimental to their team. Throwing a helmet is considered unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Players will be a team player and always put the team first. They will be coachable and ready to learn at all times.
- Players understand that the use or possession of weapons, drugs, alcohol, or any tobacco products, or participation in any illegal activities will result in suspension from the team and any league participation for the remainder of the season.
- Players will respect their equipment, take proper care of it, and if damaged or destroyed, pay to have it replaced. Players will never sit on their helmet.
- Players will perform to the best of their abilities in school. Players agree to maintain passing grades at all times or they face suspension until all grades are restored.
- Players understand that if they are suspended from school, they are suspended from the team and any league activity until the player returns to school. It is the responsibility of the players to inform their coach of any school suspension. If OHFCL discovers by any means that a player has failed to report their suspension, an additional week of suspension from the team and any league activity will result.
- ***Players understand that failure to follow the Player Code of Conduct in any way will result in sanctions that can range between a warning to permanent ejection from OHFCL.***
